Purpose

The seminar aims to disseminate the results of the study "Values and interests of adolescents in Europe" and to initiate a dialogue between participants on solutions for better youth involvement in social life, achieve their own interests and success in career. The study is based on research by the authors among more than 250 students aged 14-18, of 6 partner schools (from Bulgaria, Poland, Turkey, Slovenia, Italy and Romania) participating in Erasmus + project "Forum Theatre - a Learning Instrument for Education" - FOR LIFE and it was conducted between October 2014 - January 2015.

O b j e c t i v e s

- a. to inform the participants about the results of the study;
- b. to take into consideration general and specific issues related to the way that adolescents can achieve their interests in the actual context;
- c. to raise awareness about the importance of investment in education to achieve the interests of adolescents and success in career.
